

Relief work for those in need

Sanctions proposed by the United Nations turn the simplest of tasks in Iraq into a myriad of difficulties - simple things such as pencils are banned, alongside basic health care provisions such as paracetamol and anaesthetic.

The Human Relief Foundation is a registered charity with international headquarters based in Bradford. HRF was established in 1991 in direct response to the imposition of sanctions, which left millions of ordinary Iraqis destitute. They have since developed over ten years of practical experience in relief distribution and management across the whole of Iraq. UN figures show that one and a half million Iraqis have died from malnutrition or lack of health care due to economic sanctions. Iraqis are unable to receive basic medical treatment and the future outlook remains bleak as education and health care levels have remained stagnated for many years.

The relief work is ever growing and has expanded into Palestine, Kashmir, Afghanistan, Ethiopia and Somalia, but the primary concern remains in Iraq. The Human Relief Foundation has the administration and financial management to effectively deliver aid in the region. The terrain can be inhospitable and often dangerous, but HRF have an established technical and logistical capacity in relation to their operations. They have excellent and unrivalled recognition in this part of the world with the credibility and support to undertake effective and desperately essential relief work.

The charity runs an array of ongoing projects in different parts of the world from mobile clinics and emergency rooms in Palestine to a maternity unit in Al-Qayarah in Iraq. There are of course base schemes

such as orphan and poor family sponsorship projects, without which many thousands of individual Iraqis would suffer gravely. The Human Relief Foundation has recently been fundraising in response to the threat of war. The Baghdad offices are undertaking an emergency programme which will provide tents, emergency kits, medical supplies, food and blankets to innocent civilians in Iraq. These commodities are quintessential and will benefit the Iraqi people, even if the threatened attacks are not executed.
